The Geological Survey of Tanzania (GST) is a Scientific Department under the Tanzanian government. The scientists of the GST investigate the landscape of Tanzania, as well as its natural resources and potential hazards. The work of the organization is interdisciplinary and includes biology, geography, geology, and hydrology. The GST is a fact-finding scientific group without that works with the Ministry of Minerals. In 1925 the agency was established under the British colonial government.
