1.0 THE DAR ES SALAAM UNIVERSITY COLLEGE OF EDUCATION (DUCE)

The Dar es Salaam University College of Education (DUCE) is a Constituent College of the University of Dar es Salaam established in 2005. The main functions of the College, as stipulated in the University Charter and the Rules of 2010, are to provide integrated teaching, research and public services.  7. An applicant who is retired from the Public Service for whatever reason should not apply;
 8. An applicant should indicate three reputable referees with reliable contacts;
 9. Certificates from foreign Universities should be verified by the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU);
 10. Certificates from foreign Universities should bare a GPA calculated (out of five (5) grade points) by the Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU);
 11. Certificates from foreign examination bodies for Ordinary or Advanced level education should be verified by The National Examination Council of Tanzania (NECTA);
 12. Applicants who are currently employed by the Government should channel their application letters through their respective employers;
 13. Applicants who were Government employees should indicate in their application letters;
 14. Presentation of forged certificates and other information will necessitate legal action;
 15. A signed application letter should be written in English or Kiswahili and addressed to Principal, Dar es Salaam University College of Education, P.O. Box 2329
