#### 2.0 MARINE PARKS AND RESERVES UNIT (MPRU)

The Marine Parks and Reserves Unit was established under the Marine Parks and Reserves (MPRU) Act 29 of 1994. The MPRU is Managed by the Board of Trustees whose role among other things is to oversee management of marine parks and reserves operating under auspice of MPRU, formulating policies on Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) and related facilities, and advise the responsible Minister (currently the Minister Of Agriculture, Livestock and Fisheries) on approval, revision and amendment of general management plan of any Marine Parks including other legislative matters pertaining to the conservation and Management of Coastal and Marine resources.

#### 3.0 TANZANIA FISHERIES RESEARCH INSTITUTE (TAFIRI)

The Tanzania Veterinary Laboratory Agency (TVLA) is a Government Agency under the Ministry of Livestock and Fisheries established by the Law on Government Agencies No. 245 (amended in 2009) and announced in the Government Gazette of March 9, 2012. The agency was officially launched on July 11, 2012 by the Chief Secretary. This agency was the result of the merger of the former Central Veterinary Laboratory (CVL), Regional Centers for Investigation and Diagnosis of Veterinary Diseases (VICs), Ndorobo Research Institute (TTRI) Tanga and Ndorobo Research Center (TTRC) Kigoma.
