The applicant **MUST** also be a Holder of a Bachelor of Education in Arts (BEd.Arts) or Bachelor of Arts with Education (BA.Ed) majoring Kiswahili Language as a teaching subject, with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.8 out of 5.0 obtained from a recognized university.
